Bloodroot

This flower opens with the daylight and closes at night. Look for an open blossom and its interestingly shaped leaf.



American Goldfinch

The vibrant yellow feathers of a male goldfinch do not appear all at once. The molting process is gradual. Can you find a male that is hanging on to a few blotches of his drab winter coloring?



Nest Building

Some birds are building nests for the season. Spot a bird that is gathering material for its nest.



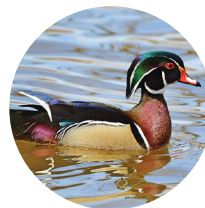
Dutchman's Breeches

These small blossoms look like pants hanging on a clothesline. Keep your eyes on the forest floor to find them.



Woodchuck

This species is one of Michigan's few true hibernators and they are awake! Can you find one foraging for food? Move slowly and keep your eyes peeled; they camouflage well with their surroundings.



Wood Duck

The male wood ducks are in their full breeding plumage. Look for them floating down a river or in a secluded pond.



Cutleaf Toothwort

This plant can be found on the forest floor. Can you find one blooming next to a trail?



Buck Rub

Bucks rub trees to remove the velvet from their antlers, mark their territory, and to relieve their hormone induced angst. Find a tree that has a rub on it.
