Reptiles & Amphibians

Hide your snake and have someone try to find it; once they find it let them hide it for you.

EXPLORATION: Frogs are some of the first amphibians to come out of their winter slumber. Listen closely to find out if frogs live in water near you. As you walk through nature look in sunny spots on the ground for frogs, snakes or lizards that are trying to get heat.
