Weekend Land Maintenance Volunteer Group



Are you looking for an opportunity to volunteer? Join a group of individuals with the desire to contribute to Chippewa Nature Center by assisting CNC's Land Management Department in providing an enjoyable experience for visitors. Activities may include trail maintenance, tree pruning and maintaining tree cages. Volunteers do not need to commit to every weekend, come as you are able.

Group Objective:

To maintain CNC trails and outdoor public spaces in collaboration with CNC staff and volunteers.

Duties & Responsibilities May Include:

- Remove debris and prune trees encroaching on trails
- Help to remove hazardous trees found in public areas and along trails
- Add dirt and gravel to low or rough trails
- Weed and remove grape vines from tree cages
- Split and stack wood for Homestead programs
- Work collaboratively with CNC staff and other volunteers

Qualifications:

- Ability to kneel, stoop, bend, lift and stand on uneven surfaces
- Ability to lift 50 lbs
- Confidence in and around running equipment
- Ability to positively interact with visitors when volunteering
- Must be able to work collaboratively with CNC staff
- Ages 15+, under 18 w/adult
