Help support these programs by caring out needed woodworking projects. These projects range from cutting “tree cookies” to making nesting boxes and more.

Position Objective:

To support CNC programs through woodworking projects in collaboration with CNC staff and volunteers.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively with CNC staff to carry out projects
- Complete projects in a timely fashion with the resources provided. Those with required equipment may do some projects at home.
- Amount of committed hours and work time are flexible and can take place throughout the year. Projects will be given on an as-needed basis.

Qualifications:

- Follow all safety precautions when using equipment and working with others. Equipment will be provided if working on site.
- Woodworking and shop experience required
- Ability to positively interact with visitors as needed when volunteering
- Ability to work independently
- Must be able to work collaboratively with CNC staff
- Ages 18+
- Volunteer background check will be performed
